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Hard Words

Microchip: An electronic device that is capable of being permanently implanted in an animal of a prescribed class of animal and that is designed to record information in a manner that can be electronically retrieved.

Dangerous Dog: A dog which has been declared to be dangerous by a Council under Part 3 of the Domestic Animals Act or a dog which by virtue of the operation of section 34A of the Domestic Animals Act is a dangerous dog.

Menacing Dog: A dog which has been declared to be a menacing dog by a Council under Part 3 of the Domestic Animals Act.

Sterilised: A dog or cat that has had a surgical procedure to remove all or part of the reproductive organs to prevent it breeding.

Working Dog: Dogs kept for working stock. Dog must be kept solely for the purpose of working cattle, sheep, alpacas or goats.

VCA: Victorian Canine Association operating as Dogs Victoria.

Approved Person: A Statutory Declaration can be witnessed by a Justice of the Peace, Pharmacist, Police Officer, Court Registrar, Bank Manager, Medical Practitioner or a Dentist or any other person named as per section 107A of the Evidence (Miscellaneous Provisions) ACT 1958.

Restricted Breeds: Pit Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Dogo Argentino and Japanese Tosa

Applicable Organisation: Australian National Cats Inc, Cats Victoria Inc, Dogs Victoria, Feline Control Council (VIC) Inc. and The Governing Council of the Cat Fancy Australia Inc.

Statutory Declaration: A statutory Declaration is sometimes called a 'stat dec'. A Statutory Declaration is a legal document and means you are telling the truth.
