#### \*IMPORTANT DATES\*

Voter Registration Deadline – October 8th Deadline to Request a Mail in Ballot – October 18th In-person Early Voting Period – October 23rd-31st Election Day – November 2nd (6AM – 9PM)

### **\*VOTER REGISTRATION\***

Eligibility to Register to Vote in NYC

- Be a citizen of the United States for at least 30 days
- · Be a legal resident of your county
- · Be 18 years of age on or before the election
- Not serving a sentence for conviction of a felony

If you don't have a record then you are not registered to vote! If you are not registered to vote, register online with your Driver's license at <a href="https://voterreg.dmv.ny.gov/motorvoter/">https://voterreg.dmv.ny.gov/motorvoter/</a>
\*You will not be able to vote in this election, but be registered for future elections

## \*MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE\*

#### Vote Early -

You must visit your designated Early Voting location from 10/25–11/1 in order to vote early. Times will vary, but your location and all of the times it is open can be found at <a href="https://findmypollsite.vote.nyc/">https://findmypollsite.vote.nyc/</a>

#### Vote on Election Day -

Polls are open from 6AM to 9PM on election day. Find your polling location at <a href="https://findmypollsite.vote.nyc/">https://findmypollsite.vote.nyc/</a>.

\*Your Early Voting location and your Election Day location ARE NOT THE SAME.

Make sure to go to the appropriate location listed using the pollsite locator.

#### \*TIPS\*

If you vote in person, stay safe, wear a mask, and abide by social distancing standards.

When filling out a paper ballot make sure to select only one option for each election or question and fill in the oval completely with a black or blue pen.

Plan to vote early as this will ensure that you have time to vote again in case of unexpected emergencies
