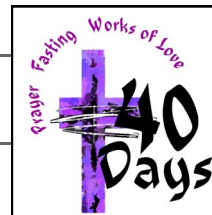

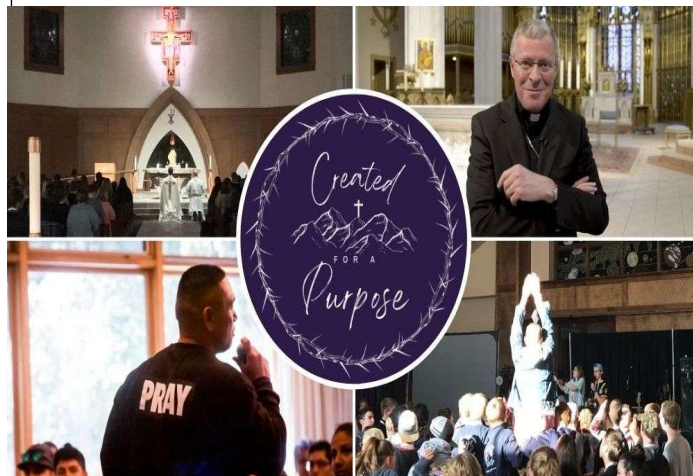
Helena Catholic Young Adult Group

What is Soul Core?

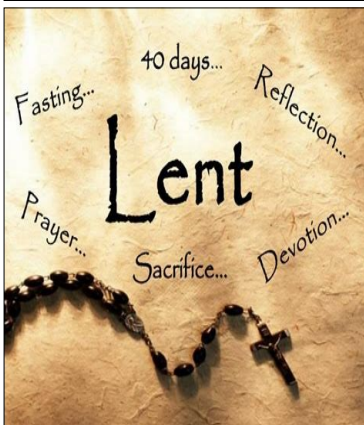
