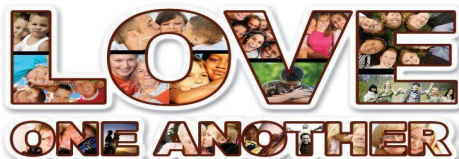

Our Lady of the Valley Parish is recruiting for a part-time Pre-K through 6th grade Religious Education Program Coordinator.

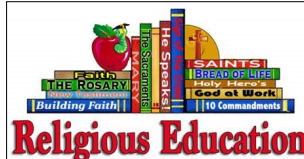

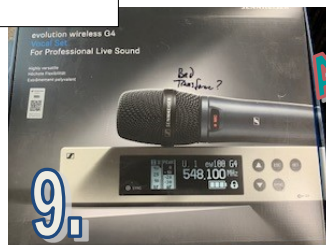
