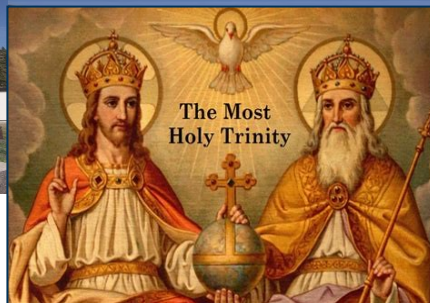

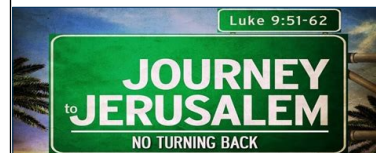
Gospel: Luke 9:11b—17

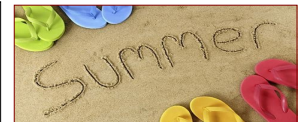
