1st Reading: Isaiah 66:10—14c

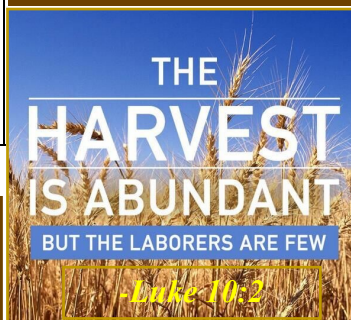
The prophet said, "Rejoice with Jerusalem and be glad because of her, all you who love her.... As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you."
