# 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time July 10th Readings

### 1st Reading: Deuteronomy 30:10-14

Moses encouraged the people to follow the law of the Lord their God with all their hearts and all their souls. This command is not "mysterious and remote" but "already in your mouths and in your hearts.'

### 2nd Reading: Colossians 1:15-20

Christ Jesus is the new image of God; Before anything came to be, he was. In him resides the fullness of power to restore to God all things: in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible.

### Gospel: Luke 10:25—37

A lawyer asked Jesus what a person must do to gain éternal life. Reminded of the command to love God and neighbor, the man inquired, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus replied by telling him the story about the good Samaritan.

### Gospel: Luke 10:38-42




