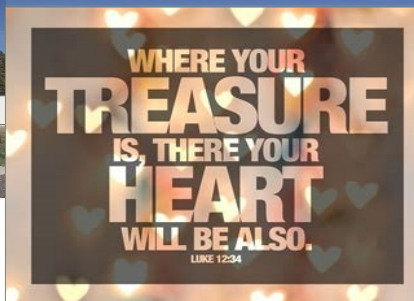

—Luke 12:49-50

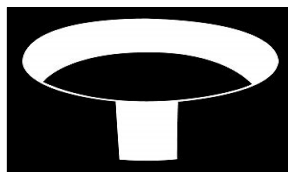

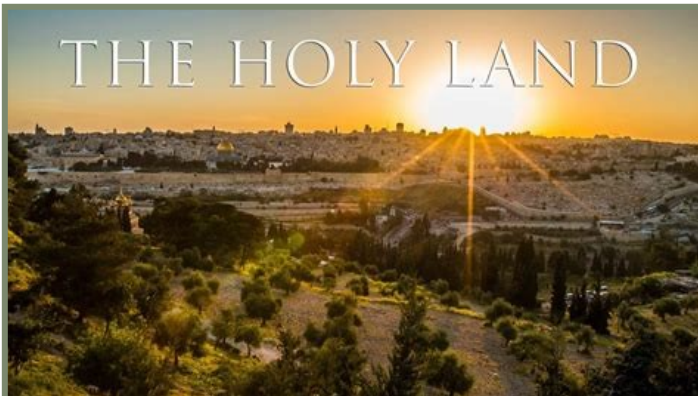

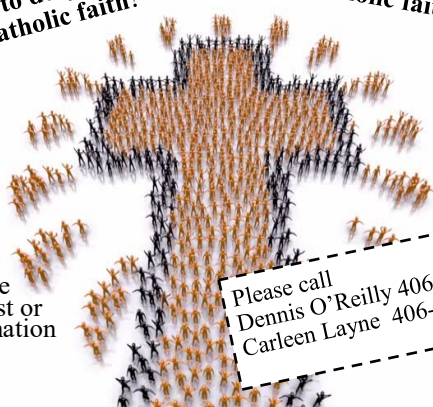
