

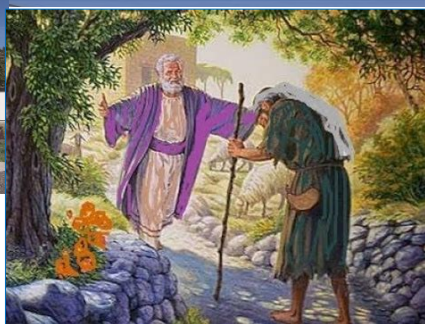

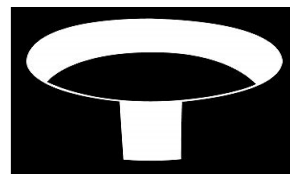

Scripture Study

"Do you understand this parable?" is a question Jesus posed to his disciples (Mark 4:13). Just as the first disciples often did not understand Jesus' many parables, so it is for listeners and readers nearly two thousand years later. This gathering will help readers to "hear" and "see" and "understand" the parables of Jesus.

This study offers a general introduction to the use of parables in the life and ministry of Jesus and the early church. *Parables of the Kingdom* helps us hear and see Jesus' parables with new eyes and renewed hearts, transforming our lives and helping us respond with new conviction to the gospel's power in our world.



Fr Dan will present *Parables of the Kingdom, Jesus and the Use of Parables in the Synoptic Tradition*. We will use the Liturgical Press-Little Rock Scripture Series text by Mary Ann Getty-Sullivan and *Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John Side by Side Parallel Gospels in Harmony*.

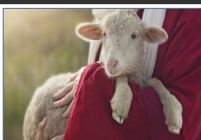
