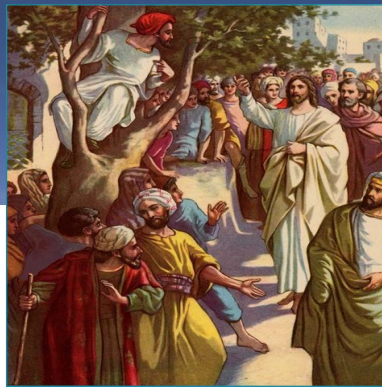

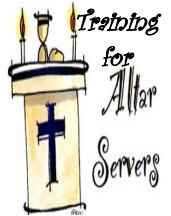
Altar Server Training

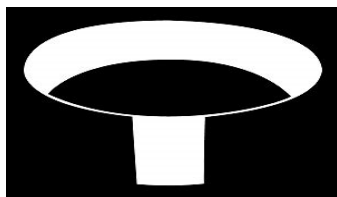

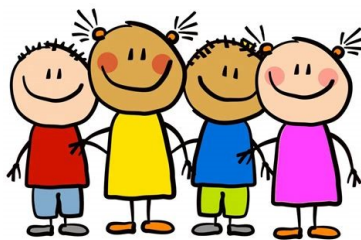

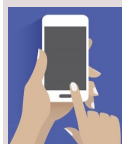
Relationship Health Assessment

Our Diocese has partnered with an organization called Communio - a nonprofit ministry that equips parishes with outreach tools and ministry strategies to evangelize and discipleship people through their marriages and relationships.

They are helping the Diocese set some ministry outcomes and ministry activities to achieve those outcomes.
