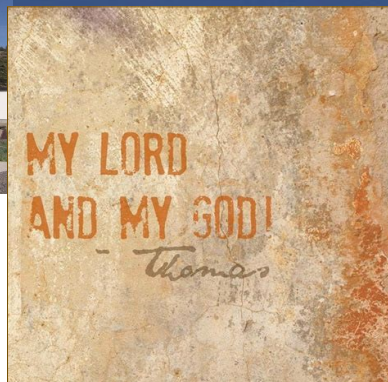

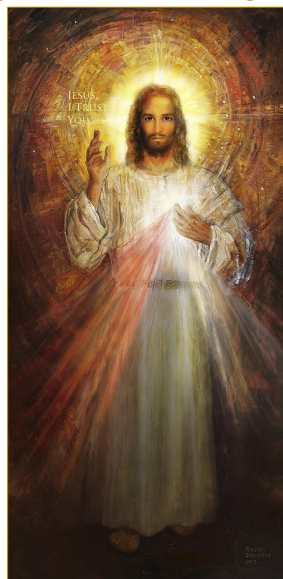

Our newly baptized member of our parish, **Jim Carney**, has been involved in a wonderful mission in Kyrgyzstan started in 1997 with the Montana Army National Guard and later by himself.

The heart program for indigent children started when two Montana nurses visited and taught Advanced Cardiac Life Support at the cardiac center. Later they got a call that an 8 year-old boy needed surgery and it would cost \$560.

The airbase in Kyrgyzstan was from 2001-2014 and he worked with the outreach group that set up the program to pay for the surgeries. They did 204 before the airbase closed and have paid for a total of 208 to date.

Jim continues the mission and currently makes pearl and stone jewelry and uses the money from the sales to pay for heart surgeries.

He is currently planning a trip to Kyrgyzstan on April 26th and has enough funds to pay for **10** surgeries at this time.
