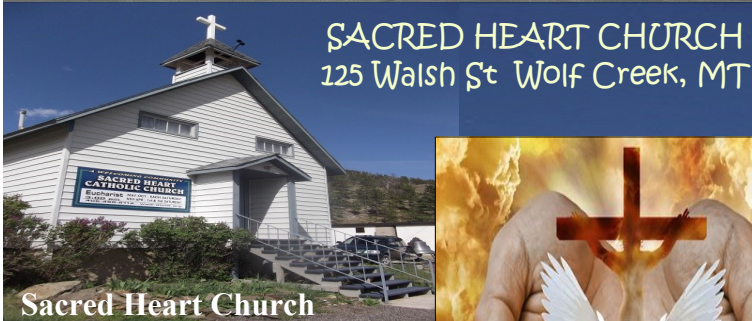

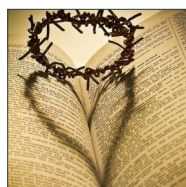

2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:16—17

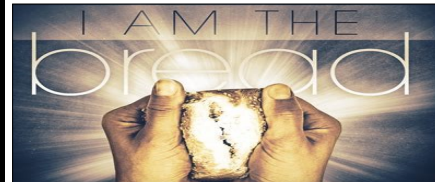
By sharing in the Eucharistic bread, Christians, though many, are one body in Christ.
