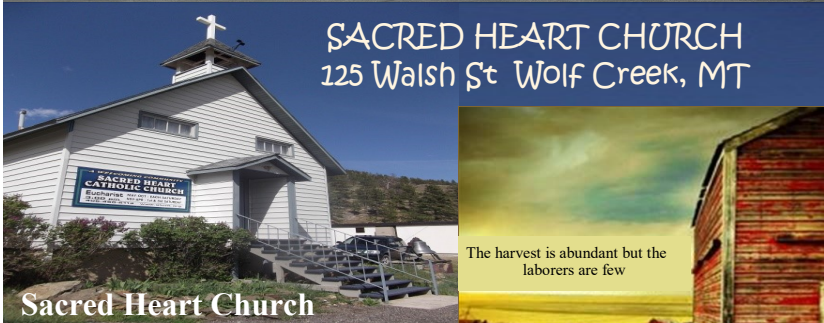

1st Reading: Jeremiah 20:10—13

OLV is looking for someone to take the lead on the Liturgical Environment Committee.

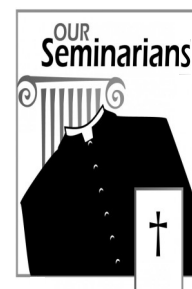

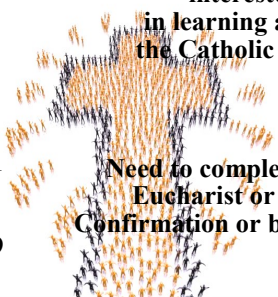

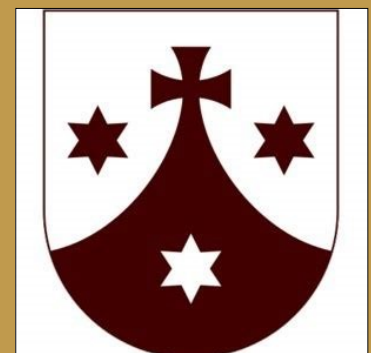
