### 1st Reading: Daniel 7:9—10, 13—14

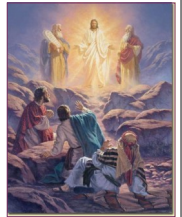
Daniel had a vision of the Ancient One seated on a throne of fire and wearing snow-bright clothing. One like a Son of man came on clouds to receive glory.

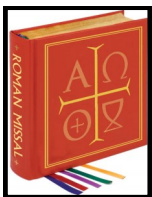
