Paul urged the Romans to offer their bodies to God as a living sacrifice and not to conform to this age but to be transformed by God.

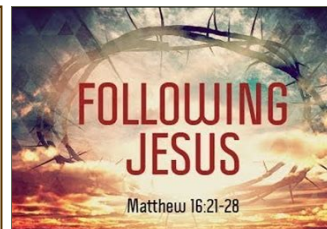
