1st Reading: Sirach 27:30—28:7

Forgive the injustice of your neighbor, for then your own sins will be pardoned. Remember death, stop sinning, recall the commandments, love your neighbor, think of God's covenant, and overlook the faults of others.

2nd Reading: Romans 14:7—9

Gospel: Matthew 18:21—35

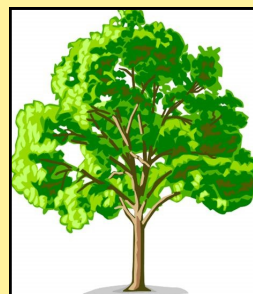

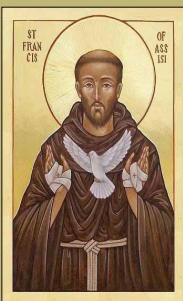

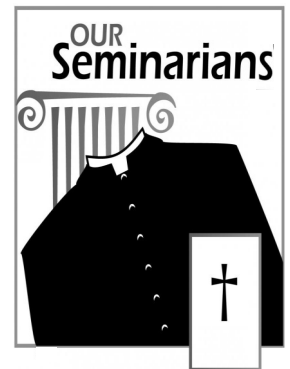
