1st Reading: Ezekiel 18:15-28

The LORD spoke through Ezekiel: "Hear now, house of Israel: ... If he turns from the wickedness he has committed, and does what is right and just, he shall preserve his life."

2nd Reading: Philippians 2:1-11






For the Synod

Sacred Heart Mission Suspended

Bishop Vetter visited the community of the Sacred Heart Mission at Wolf Creek on Saturday, September 16. The Bishop, citing a shortage of priestly availability, announced the suspension, (not closure), of the mission until further notice. The 3 pm Saturday weekend mass will continue to be celebrated until October 21, at which time weekend masses will suspend.

We continue to pray for all of the suspended missions in our Diocese and for the blessing of more priestly vocations in the days ahead.
