




Due to recent software changes at St. Peter's Healthcare, our ministers are unable to receive a list of OLV parishioners who wish to be visited while in the hospital.

Sacred Heart Mission Suspended

Bishop Vetter visited the community of the Sacred Heart Mission at Wolf Creek on Saturday, September 16. The Bishop, citing a shortage of priestly availability, announced the suspension, (not closure), of the mission until further notice. The 3 pm Saturday weekend mass will continue to be celebrated until October 21, at which time weekend masses will suspend.

We continue to pray for all of the suspended missions in our Diocese and for the blessing of more priestly vocations in the days ahead.
