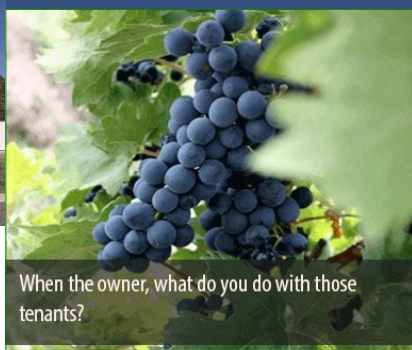

Due to recent software changes at St. Peter's Healthcare, our ministers are unable to receive a list of OLV parishioners who wish to be visited while in the hospital.

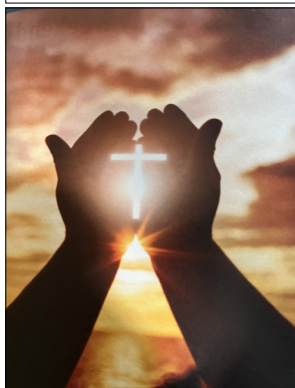

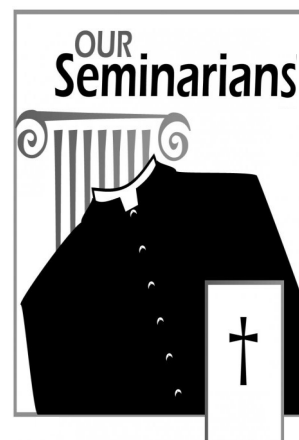

Bishop Vetter visited the community of the **Sacred Heart Mission at Wolf Creek** on Saturday, September 16.
