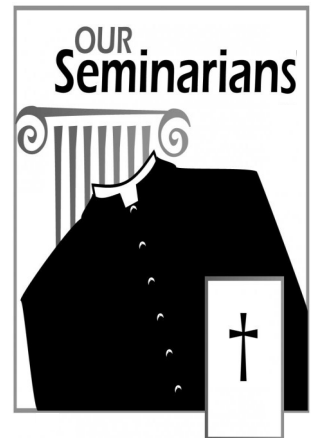

Bishop Vetter visited the community of the **Sacred Heart Mission at Wolf Creek** on Saturday, September 16. The Bishop, citing a shortage of priestly availability, announced the suspension, (not closure), of the mission until further notice. The 3 pm Saturday weekend mass will continue to be celebrated until October 21, at which time weekend masses will suspend.
