Due to recent software changes at St. Peter's Healthcare, our ministers are unable to receive a list of OLV parishioners that have been admitted. If you are aware of a family member or


friend from our parish who wishes to be visited while a patient, please call the parish office.

Scholarship Award Amount – The scholarship recipients will receive a code that will cover \$360 of the registration fee. This amount will cover camp if done prior to February 1.


**Basis of Award** – The camper must be an Our Lady of the Valley parishioner and have need of the scholarship.


