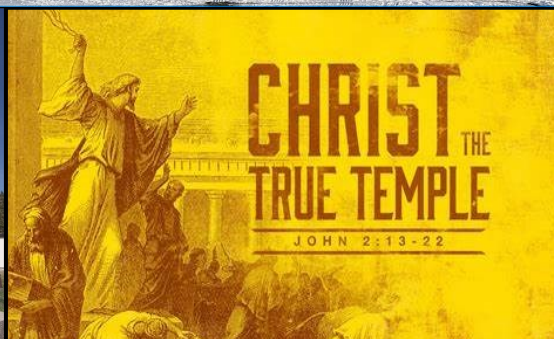

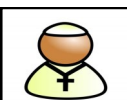

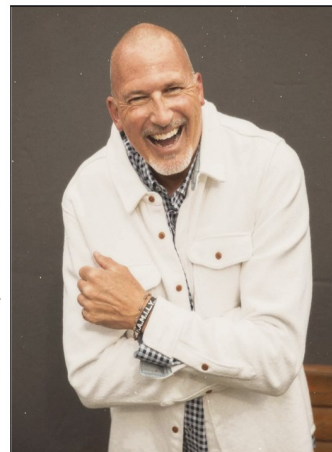

He has been a youth minister for over 30 years and for the last 6 years has taught Teen Confirmation Program at The Church of the Good Shepherd in Beverly Hills, California.

He is a board member of a non-profit that feeds the homeless called Feed My Poor, Inc.

He is the founding member of FiveHive Studios where they use A.I. technology process to create filmmaking faster and more affordable.

He was an associate producer of the film "Sound of Freedom."

The Faithful of the Diocese of Helena are invited to the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of St. Helena to take place at **Noon on Tuesday, March 19, 2024.**

The Chrism Mass is a special celebration in the liturgical life of the Church in the Diocese of Helena. Bishop Vetter will bless the Holy Oils for use in the coming year and priests of the diocese will renew their priestly promises.

The **Oil of the Sick** is used in Sacrament of the Sick to bring the strengthening and healing power of Christ who is at work in the Church by the action of the Holy Spirit.

The **Oil of Catechumens** is used at Baptism, to strengthen (with wisdom and courage to live the Gospel) and purify candidates (from original sin) before baptizing with water.

The **Oil of Chrism**, or Sacred Chrism, is a mixture of olive oil and balsam fragrance used just after Baptism, and to seal candidates for Confirmation. It is also used to anoint the hands of priests and the heads of bishops at Ordination.

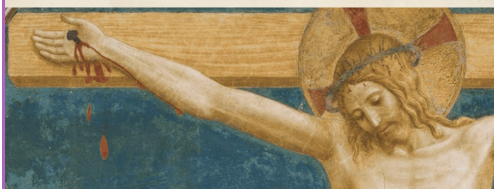

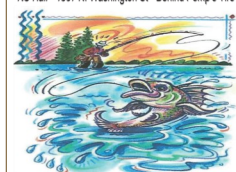
