- 1. The book's title and the author's name **10 points**
- 2. Your rating of the book (1-5 stars) and your explanation (why did you give it this rating?) **30 points**
- 3. Book summary **30 points**
- 4. Select 4-5 important quotes from the story and explain them **30 points**

Optional: create a new front cover for the book. Be creative! +5 points

You will present this review during the second week of school. I am so excited to meet you and see what you have created!
