Detailed Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrive in Delhi

Upon arrival at the Delhi International Airport, you are met and assisted by one of our representatives and transferred to the hotel.

Evening meet for a cocktail with Rani Chandresh Kumari (Princess Jodhpur and former Member of Parliament – Chairman of Parliamentary Committee for Empowerment of Women in India) (Subject to her being in Residence in Delhi)

Overnight at Hotel [-/-/-]

Day 2: In Delhi

After breakfast, begin your guided tour of the capital today highlighting the remarkable contrast between Old and New Delhi.



Take a cycle-rickshaw ride through the busy lanes of the colourful **Chandni Chowk** Market followed by a visit to the **Jama Masjid**.

In the afternoon, visit the **Humayun's Tomb, Gandhi Museum,** and drive past the President's house.

Overnight at Hotel [B/-/-]

Day 3: Drive to Agra

Drive Distance & Time: 210 km/ 4.5 hours approx.

After breakfast at the hotel, drive to Agra. On arrival check into your hotel. In the afternoon proceed for sightseeing tour of **Red Fort** & **Itmad-ud-daulah**.

Overnight at Hotel [B/-/-]

Day 4: Drive to Jaipur

Drive Distance & Time: 238 km/ 4 hours approx.

Early this morning, go for a private guided tour of the **Taj Mahal** - It is arguably at its most atmospheric during sunrise and we recommend an early start to be first through the doors as the sun rises. (**Note: Taj Mahal remains closed on Fridays**)

Return to hotel for breakfast after which we begin the drive to Jaipur. En-route visit Fatehpur Sikri.

Overnight at Hotel [B/-/-]



Day 5: In Jaipur

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a half day tour of the **Amber Fort** built for the rulers of Rajasthan, which stands boldly on a hill.

Next take a tour of the City Palace Complex, part of which is still the home of the former ruling family. Beside the City Palace Complex is the Jantar Mantar, built as an astronomical observatory for the maharajah almost 300 years ago and still operates with incredible accuracy today. Visit the bazaars of the old city which are a vibrant array of clothes, fabrics, leather goods, flowers, jewellery, fruit, vegetables and more. During the city tour, visit a workshop for having hands on experience in block printing.

Overnight at Hotel [B/-/-]

Day 6: In Jaipur

After breakfast visit the **Gyan Museum**. Later, go shopping for bangles, Indian attire for the women (Sarees / kurta) or Juttis (Rajasthani traditional footwear).

In the evening visit **Dera Amer** for Champagne BBQ with a cultural dance show.

Overnight at Hotel [B/-/-]

Day 7: Drive to Delhi for final departure
Drive Time (Jaipur – Delhi): 256 km/ 5 hours approx.

After an early breakfast drive to Delhi International Airport to connect to your onward flight. [B]

(Reporting time for international flights is at least 3 hours prior to flight departure time)
