Rockefeller And I - Part 1 is a solo performance in which John R. Maria Gutierrez, son of a low income, sometimes no-income, Dominican immigrant family confronts his life experience with another John, John D. Rockefeller Jr. and his 10 personal commandments on how to live your life.

Rockefeller And I will be the second time Uwe Mengel creates a performance specifically designed for the sidewalk in front of La MaMa. In May 2019, he created on the sidewalk the participatory performance *Everyday Murder*.

John Maria Gutierrez is a multidisciplinary actor, mover, maker, and educator originally from Washington Heights, NY also known as "Little Dominican Republic". As the first person in his family born in the US, John is carving out and balancing their own identity within their family, cultural history, and artistic expression.

Uwe Mengel began writing and directing interactive cross- media projects in East Germany, among them the performance Association for the dissemination of the notion that the earth is flat, which was banned after the first showing.

After his escape from East Germany he created his unique participatory performances at many Theater Festivals, including Melbourne, Australia; Zuerich, Switzerland; Berlin, Germany; San Antonio, Texas.
