- What is your opinion on local government and 3 waters reforms?
- What should local government be doing about climate change?

#### Access to information

- Could the local authority you are standing for be more open with its information and meeting access? If so, how?
- What are your ideas for helping people who don't have good internet access, to be involved and have their say?

## **Participation**

- What part of the community or business sector does the.Council need to work more closely with?
- What are your ideas for getting more public participation in local government decisions?
- Who do you think is missing out?

## Manawhenua

- Who are the manawhenua where you are standing?
- How will you support their involvement in decisionmaking as per the Local Government Act?

## Accountability

- How will you balance short term benefit with long term needs and concerns? Give an example.
- How can I trust you will follow through on your promises?
- As a councillor how will you work collaboratively with your fellow councillors to deliver on your promise?
