Decision Meeting Minutes:

City of Martinez Engineers Updates:

- Lower Alhambra Creek Watershed Management Plan (LACWMP) is a "living document".
 - Things will need to be reviewed as the years progress including the frequency of meetings with the AWC.
 - More training sessions with City staff.
 - Is this in the City budget?
 - Some ongoing maintenance for the creek is included in City Budget.
 - Previously appealed to the City Council seeking some level support from Measure X (General Fund Augmentation), who was generally supportive but could not commit for future councils.
 - Currently working with the County to get the stream gauge installed (funded program).
- Upstream from the Lower Alhambra Creek, is the washout that produced a lot of the siltation at the extension of Haven St., replanted willow poles there.
 - They seem to be doing well so far.
 - 5-year monitoring requirement, so LSA will continue to monitor the willows.
- Trimming
 - Tree between Ward and Main needs to be addressed
- Is the City starting the desilting project this year?
 - Permitting will take at least a year, so probably not this year
 - Planning process should start pretty quickly to start project in 2024
 - In the early fall, expect to connect to discuss the planning/permitting process for the desilting [Check in for the September Council Meeting]
 - Primarily looking at the vegetation plan
