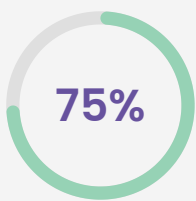




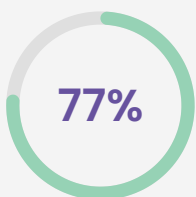
# BibliU

## DEI & TEXTBOOK AFFORDABILITY

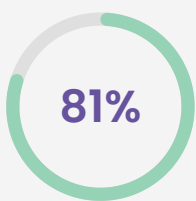


of students agree that no-cost textbooks would improve DEI.

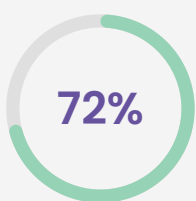


of students agree content affordability is key to supporting DEI.

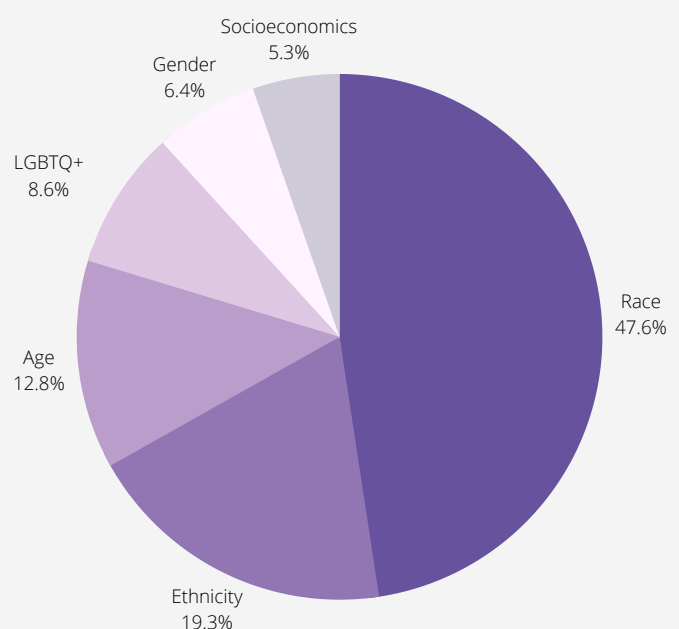


of students said their institution values diversity & inclusion.

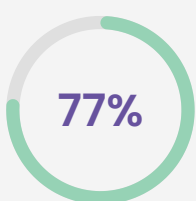
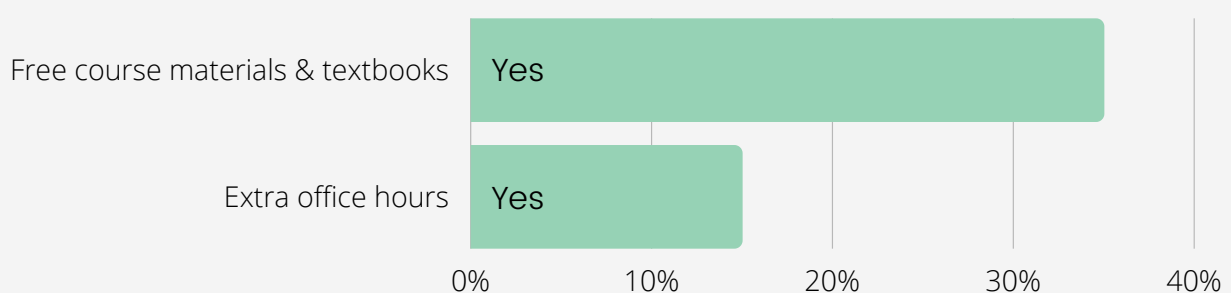
