Voice From The Classroom. - Dr. Joel Livingston, Interim Assistant Principal

- Dr Livingston shared his experience for the past two months at Erie working in the middle school.
- Started initiative with small groups and to help correct the culture in middle school
- Monday Check-ins with teachers
- 9 suspension incidents since April
 - Most suspensions are 3-4 days
 - o Re-entry meeting to bring students back in
- Erie has a strong foundation, but middle school is it's own sector and we have to think it differently from elementary
- Most of the students who are struggling are new to Erie
 - o How do we invite new students into Erie
- Recommend Erie have two different leaders for elementary and middle school
- Push for more diversity amongst staff

Principal Search Update - Tony Sutton

- Jess Zander identified 6 candidates for the next round
 - o 1 Candidate already accepted a job from another school
 - Now we are trying to expedite the process
 - 3 can no longer engage now and 1 will no longer re locate so now we have 2 candidates for the position
 - o 2 Paths:



- Path 1: look for more candidates and look at the original list and should we revisit some of the previous candidates. Fearful that we may lose the candidates that we already have
 - Path 2: go with the 2 candidates that we have
