
The City of Chicago is offering a new program to waive the standard permit fees (over a \$3,000 value) for any Chicago homeowner who decides to replace their full lead service line.

What's Involved in a Lead Service Line Replacement?

The service line brings the water from the water main to your house. In Chicago, many service lines to single family and two-flat homes are lead. Replacing the line involves digging a trench from the street to your house. The new copper water service will enter your house through the floor or the wall and connect to your existing plumbing at the first water shut-off valve.



The lead service line ownership is split between the City (public side) and the homeowner (private side). Under this program, the homeowner will replace the full line and the City will fully subsidize the cost of all standard permitting fees. See leadsafechicago.org for details and exclusions.
