Another busy week gone by - we can hardly believe it! -the first month of the school year finished! Time flies when you are having fun. Since it is that time of year where the weather has started to change, please may we kindly ask for donations of boxes of tissues for the classrooms.

In English this week, we have started learning about the structures and features of instructions and begun to use these to write our own. We certainly enjoyed reading the children's interesting ideas of 'How to Catch a Big Cat'. In Maths this week, we are continuing to work with column addition, focussing on 4-digit numbers and progressing to missing box problems and worded questions throughout the week. In Topic, the children learnt about the 8-point compass and used four-figure grid references to determine the locations of various East Barnet landmarks. Art this week involved using watercolours to paint landscapes, which was inspired by the work of the artist Lowry. In ICT this week, the children completed their coding (J2code) topic and they are now able to string pieces of code together. In Science this week, the children have been preparing for an experiment, which will utilise their states of matter knowledge.
