The children had the opportunity to have a look at some real newspapers and also played the role of journalists. Now they have gathered all their information, they are busy writing their final newspaper reports.

Additionally, we continued our Integrated Studies topic by looking at our big question What natural features do we have in the United Kingdom? Last week, the focus was on the mountains in the UK. This week, the children learnt all about rivers. In ICT, the children continued to use the stop motion app, on the iPads, in order to see how taking a series of photos and putting them together can create an animation. They have now started to prepare the props they need in order to use this app to create an animation of their story. ## <u>Times Tables</u>
