TODAY IN YOUR MEET UP

Passage: Hebrews 4: 14-16:

Take a minute in silence and then have one person read the verses out (very slowly) giving time for the verses to 'sink in'. Then spend a minute in silence as you reflect on the beauty of Jesus.

1. What is your natural instinct about how Jesus behaves towards us **in** our weakness and sin?
2. How does that impact your relationship with Him?
3. Read Isaiah 52:13 – 53:12. How does it change the way you view Jesus' ability to sympathise with us in our weakness?
4. Re-read Hebrews 4: 14-16 in the message version (there is a copy at the bottom) and spend a few minutes in silence. Repent where you have misjudged Jesus and rejoice in the truth!

14-16 Now that we know what we have Jesus, this great High Priest with ready access to God let's not let it slip through our fingers. We don't have a priest who is out of touch with our reality. He's been through weakness and testing, experienced it all, all but the sin. So let's walk right up to him and get what he is so ready to give. Take the mercy, accept the help.
