Seven Generations Scholarship Policy

Attending Rosseau Lake College is an opportunity that can be supported with financial assistance through scholarships. Scholarships at RLC are awarded based on student merit and achievements in academics, leadership, service and co curricular involvement. Boarding students will be given preference. This policy provides an outline to ensure continued success of the student. The policy outlines responsibilities of the partner community, Rosseau Lake College, the individual student and the respected legal guardian(s). Individuals that receive financial support are expected to adhere to the guidelines provided. Visit rosseaulakecollege.com for more information about Admissions at Rosseau Lake College.

Application Process:

The application process for tuition sponsorship consists of the following steps:

Legal Guardians contact the individual in the community that oversees education to document the intent to apply for admissions to Rosseau Lake College. At this time, parent(s), guardian(s), and the individual will sign the release of information forms. The signed document authorizes representatives from Rosseau Lake College and the education representative (if applicable), to discuss the applicant when deemed appropriate. This is to be done by January 31st. This supports both Rosseau Lake College administratively and respective Communities' fiscal year (if applicable).

- Applicants and/or their guardians are to begin the application process by completing the following steps:
 - Online Application Form
 - Two years of academic records
 - Teacher evaluation form
 - Video essay
 - Signed policy by all parties
 - Interview with Admissions and RLC designates (video conference)
- 3. It is the responsibility of the parent(s) or guardian(s) to arrange the required interview with Rosseau Lake College and to inform the individual in the community that oversees education with the date and time of the interview. Grades and documentation must be provided in order to schedule an interview. In some cases, It may be necessary for the Admissions representative from RLC to obtain further information. The final decision of acceptance is decided by RLC and the individual that oversees education in the partner community. (If applicable)

The above documents must be provided to Rosseau Lake College Admissions representative or a designate by **February 28th** or the individual will not be considered for admission.



Specific requirements

While at RLC, A student will have full academic support in many forms. This includes supportive study, mentor group, clubs, experiential outdoor learning, Indigenous lensed curriculum, and various sport activities, exposure to new challenges, small class sizes, excellent teacher to student ratio, and a small supportive community. Due to this, we ask that students submit and maintain the following:

- Submit each grade assessment to the community's education representative from each semester
- Submit: A donor video and two thank you letters describing the positive impacts of the donor's contribution per semester
- Adhere to the <u>RLC Parent Student</u> <u>Handbook</u> regulations
- Regular scheduled meetings with the Indigenous Seven Generations Program Coordinator

Failure to adhere to any of these requirements will result in RLC and the community partner to begin a process of academic accountability. This may come in the form of restorative circles, academic contracts, and continued contact with parents and/or guardians. If the student is unable to maintain academic and/or personal integrity the individual may be subject to withdrawal of sponsorship and enrolment. Parent responsibilities include the following as outlined in the Continuous Enrolment Contract.

- For withdrawals prior to June 1st, I am responsible for one full semester of the annual tuition.
- For withdrawals after June 1st, I am responsible for the total year's tuition.

c) I understand that the Application Fee and Enrolment Fee are not refundable.

Parents must be prepared to accept the financial responsibility of additional costs that are over and above tuition fees. This can come in the form of uniforms, clothing, additional courses fees, books, overnight accommodation, extra meals, travel, and other supplies. Payment of the fees below are the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s). These fees are not the responsibility of the sponsoring First Nation (If applicable). Associated costs are:

- Application fee of \$200 is due with the application and when applying.
- There is an 'enrolment fee' of \$2000 (day student) and \$3000 (boarding student) that is due with the first tuition installment and upon accepting our offer of admission.
