Obedience to God ~ All or Nothing

When Saul was anointed as king over Israel, the Lord commanded him to go against the Amalekites and utterly destroy them. He was to destroy all that was theirs. Additionally, he was to spare no person, man, woman, child or infant.

Saul defeated the Amalekites but kept for himself the finest sheep and cattle. When confronted by Samuel, Saul made the claim that these animals, the best of what the Amalekites had, were to be used for sacrifices to the Lord.

Samuel then replied to Saul's lack of wisdom: "Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the Lord? **To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams.**" 1 Samuel 15:22

This disobedience did not work out well for Saul and he lost his throne because of it. There are consequences for disobedience.

Does disobedience still exist as a problem for God's people today? Do we struggle with giving up 100% of what the Lord asks us to put out of our lives? Do we want to hang on to just a small piece of that favorite sin? Obedience to God is an "all or nothing" proposition. If we desire joy, if we desire a deep and sustaining relationship with our Savior, we will do away with those things that the Lord demands -- all of them.
