Jesus can make you clean.

In the Gospel of Mark, we read about a man stricken with leprosy, an infectious disease which causes visible sores on the skin. In those times, people suffering from leprosy were considered “unclean” outcasts, required to live separately from the rest of the community (to prevent it from spreading).

The leper’s condition Mark tells us about is a graphic illustration of sin’s destructive power in the lives of those who have not received Christ’s salvation...

*⁴⁰ Now a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, “If You are willing, You can make me clean.” ⁴¹ Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, “I am willing; be cleansed.” ⁴² As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed. **Mark 1: 40-42***

It is no different with each of us and our salvation.

All that is needed is that we recognize our sin, humble ourselves before Christ, and ask for forgiveness.

Jesus will have compassion on us, for He is willing to heal us of our spiritually fatal condition.

The healing is immediate and requires nothing else of us — an expression of faith in Jesus begins the cleansing.
