The Gift of Faith

The very first gift we receive as new believers is the gift of faith. This new faith is, as Paul states in Romans 12:3, "... according to the measure of faith as God has assigned." Each according to God's sovereign knowledge of our needs and work He holds in store for us. We do not all have the same measure of faith, but receive a portion based on God's will for us as individuals.

My question for you today is: have you opened that gift to its full depth?

In Mark 9:14 – 27 we read of the story of the father with a demon-possessed son. The disciples tried but could not cast out the demon. The father then says to Jesus, "... if you can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." The "if" was not, and can not be a measure of Jesus' power. "If" is always conditional bringing into question the sufficiency of the person or thing to which it is addressed. There is no "if" with regard to the sufficiency of Christ! It was, in fact, an admittance by the father that his faith was lacking; his unbelief was great.

Jesus replied, "If you can believe, anything is possible."

The father responded, "I believe, help my unbelief." With this statement, he acknowledges that he has faith, but also recognizes that his unbelief, or lack of faith, is huge. While he has been given a measure of faith, he recognizes that he falls far short of exercising the full measure allotted to him. Therefore, he asks Jesus to "help my unbelief." He asks for his unbelief to shrink and his faith to grow.

How are you doing in your walk of faith? Faith forges greater faith. "We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly . . . " 2 Thessalonians 1:3
