What Does the Lord Require of You?

Micah 6:8

*He has shown you, O man, what is good;
And what does the LORD require of you
But to do justly, To love mercy,
And to walk humbly with your God?*

In God's court, Israel has questioned Him about what they can do to please Him. They suggest burnt offerings, calves of one year old, thousands of rams, 10,000 rivers of oil, and even their first born.

However, God replies that He has shown them what is good. It is simply to do what the Lord requires, and that is to do justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with God.

What does that look like to us?

To do justly is the very basis of the Golden Rule: treat others as you would have them treat you.

To love mercy, not simply to be merciful, but to love showing mercy to others.

To walk humbly with our God means that we humble ourselves in all of our activities. Charles Spurgeon suggests we humble ourselves in our motives, when we are under trial, toward our brothers and sisters in Christ, and when dealing with sinners, among many other situations.

In 1 Samuel 15, Samuel states: *"Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams."*

The Lord will be glorified in our justice, mercy, and humility. Good words to keep close at hand!
