And then you have this great truth of Ephesians 2: 4-6 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

Let us all meditate today on our devotion to our great God and be truly encouraged by His devotion to us!!
