THE WILL OF GOD FOR YOUR LIFE

"I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect."

Romans 12: 1-2

ave you ever wondered what the will of God is for your life? Usually,

when we ask this question, we seek specific answers for our lives. We want to answer the who, what, and when questions we often ask. The truth is that the Bible shows us what the will of God is again and again. This might be stated in knowing the general will of God. This is found by asking how He wants us to live our lives.

One such example of the will of God is found in Romans 12:1-2. In verse 1, in light of the great salvation that has been provided to us through the work of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection, an appeal is made for us to live in wholehearted surrender unto God.

Then, in verse 2, we are instructed to not be conformed to the world; instead, we are to be transformed by the renewal of our minds. Conforming to the world was how we lived our lives before Jesus. Now, we are to think and live differently, and this is done by the renewal of our mind. As we daily yield to the work of the Holy Spirit, we are changed from the inside out. Then, in the last part of verse 2, we see that being transformed by the renewal of our mind helps us to discern the will of God for our lives.

The reality is that when we are living out the general will of God for our lives, the who, what, and when questions are often answered. Start obeying God with what you know; in time, He will answer the who, what, and when questions in your life.
