

New York designer and long-time India resident Peter D'Ascoli has collaborated with Chester's, the artisanal furniture maker from Bangalore, to create a range of upholstered furniture featuring the designer's signature printed fabrics. 'Chester's creates the best handmade upholstery I have found in India, and their high-quality, artisanal approach perfectly matches the D'Ascoli ethos of small-batch, sustainable design. Together we offer the interior design community statement sofas and chairs inspired by historic influences ranging from Persian carpets and royal Indian brocades, to vintage fabrics that could have been heirlooms or pieces found in an antique shop.'

Since the pandemic lockdowns many of us have turned our focus inward on ourselves, our families, and our homes. And often this has been accompanied by a newfound awareness and scrutiny of our environment and the objects that surround us. This upholstery range offers furniture that uplifts both aesthetically, through color and pattern, and also technically through our material quality and artisanal approach.

The collection includes 10 pieces, all made from 100% printed linen or a mix of linen and 100% cotton.

CHESTER'S

Chester's 35 year legacy is rooted in high-quality leather and hand-crafted heritage furniture.

Traveling through Europe Chester's founder, MV Ramaswamy, was inspired to bring the generous forms of European 19th century furniture back home to Bangalore, and explore these traditional techniques in an Indian context. Built on an exchange of knowledge and skills between India and Europe, Chester's has built a reputation as a highly experienced furniture maker, creating the timeless designs that last generations.

The luxury of a Chester's piece comes from the weeks and months spent carefully crafting fabric and structure into a perfect form. It is drawn from the years Chester's craftspeople spend as apprentices and the lifetime they spend refining their skills. Most of all, the luxury of a Chester's piece is found in its longevity and the quality of the time spent using them.

D'ASCOLI

New York designer Peter D'Ascoli has been traveling the world studying decorative arts for forty years, and his work in fashion and interiors is driven by curiosity and inspired by a passion for historic decoration and exotic cultures. Formally trained in Textile Design at the Fashion Institute of Technology in Manhattan, his early work with handcrafted Indian textiles for the government of India has given him an enduring love for the art and culture of that ancient civilization.

In 2006 D'Ascoli founded the Talianna Studio in New Delhi – a design and product development atelier – creating luxury products for fashion and interior decoration using ancient and modern production techniques.





JAMAVAR CHAIR

The Jamavar group of seating is inspired by the famed shawls of Kashmir that have been favored by Indian nobility for centuries and had reached the pinnacle of European fashion for much of the nineteenth century. Prized for their detailed paisleys, stylized bhuti, and ornamental stripes, our ensemble mixes an array of patterns engineered on single, double, and three seat sofas paying homage to one of the most enduring styles in the rich Indian design vocabulary.




















NOMAD CHAIR

CAVENDISH


CHAIR








VIONNET
