Spark Conference St. Dominic School



St. Dominic School teachers spent an energizing and informative day at the Spark Conference, held at Corporate College East and sponsored by Lakewood Catholic Academy. This conference is designed to inspire and energize teachers as they head back to school. The keynote speaker, Kim Bearden, is a co-founder of the Ron Clark Academy in Atlanta. She spoke about ways to engage students, promote academic rigor, and create a culture and climate of success. In the afternoon, teachers attended breakout sessions on topics including Best Practices in Literacy Instruction, Best Practices in STEM, and Best Practices in Literature and the Arts. Marydenise Dunagan, our kindergarten teacher, said, “**I appreciate the new approaches to learning that I engaged in along with other colleagues from the Diocese. The Spark Conference rekindled my enthusiasm for back to school.**”

Back to School St. Dominic School

Our day school students will be headed back to school on August 28. There are some changes to the school routine this year, including:

Arrival Pattern- During morning drop off, buses will now stop on the Winslow side of the building instead of the parking lot. Parents who drive their children to school should pull up to the main doors and let them out of the car there. If parents wish to accompany the students to the building, they must park in the designated area.

School Supplies- Forget those detailed and expensive supply lists this year. Instead, each student must pay \$25 and all school supplies will be provided. They need only bring headphones and, for our older students, locker organization supplies.

One thing that hasn't changed is that the teachers and staff at St. Dominic School can't wait to see our students and begin the school year.
