We connect people to place and co-create with them the change, experiences and stories that empower and reimagine our relationship with the coast, environment and heritage.

We are a registered charity (charity number SCo46429).



Our Story

Since the days when Greyhope Bay was a dream of creating a centre in Aberdeen at one of the best spots in Scotland to watch dolphins, we have built a café and community facility from scratch, respecting the environment and the historical value of the site.

The Greyhope Bay Centre is now a place where people gather to share local knowledge, resources, and ideas on how to better improve our connection with the coast whilst watching dolphins and enjoying a coffee.

We operate collaboratively in an open and co-creative way whilst pushing the boundaries of the ways projects are normally delivered.

What we do

- We operate a café community space and learning centre at the best spot in the UK for dolphin watching.
- We launched the first off-grid café and learning centre in Aberdeen. We operate without connection to grid power and water and use alternative hybrid energy and circular rainwater technology.
- We host creative and heritage-based workshops and events led by local people to share knowledge and learn new skills.
- We run coastal based educational programmes for school groups year round.
- We host community monthly meetings for people to co-create with us our future events and programmes.
- We create initiatives that bring community groups and local businesses together to take care of our local environment and heritage.

School visits to Greyhope Bay

Greyhope Bay is an off-grid eco facility, which offers your class the opportunity to learn outdoors and connect with their local coastline. We have two curriculum-linked learning programmes to choose from, which have been designed to engage and inspire children of all ages, from primary to secondary school.

School visits to Greyhope Bay operate on **Wednesdays**, with morning and afternoon sessions available. Summer slots book quickly, so enquire early to not miss out. We look forward to welcoming your class soon!



Our Programmes:

- **Coastal Discovery:** Take a journey of coastal discovery as we go on a guided tour to the beaches that surround the Greyhope Bay Centre. With the help of our Engagement and Learning Officer, pupils will explore the rocky shore habitat, learning more about the creatures that live there and how they survive. We'll also focus on how we can make the most of our amazing beaches, while being safe and environmentally friendly!
- **Sustainability and Eco-Tourism:** Your class will learn more about the Greyhope Bay Centre itself and how it operates as an off-grid attraction. We'll go on a guided tour of the site's facilities, from the solar panels that power it, to our state-of-the-art compostable toilets! We'll end the session by putting your class's problem-solving and creativity to the test by challenging them to design their own eco-friendly attraction!

Travel Subsidies:

Thanks to generous support from TotalEnergies and Bumi Armada, we are able to offer a transport subsidy to schools wishing to visit Greyhope Bay and take part in our programmes. The subsidy is available to schools within the Aberdeen City and Shire areas and covers 75% of transport costs, up to a maximum of £200. Please submit a booking enquiry for full details.


Uncover Aberdeen's stunning coastline and use locally sourced willow to create a beautiful fish platter with local basket maker Helen Jackson.

Watercolour Seascapes for Beginners and Improvers with Emma Louise Wilson



Phase 2 - Greyhope Bay is expanding

After 18 months of opening the Greyhope Bay Centre, we are ready to grow.

- We need more space to accommodate all the people coming to the café and joining our workshops.
- We want to grow based on the ideas and input of people like you who use the space, come on a regular basis to join us and value the work that we do.
- We have launched a series of workshops for you to come and CO-CREATE with us the space you want to see at Torry Battery.

We have hosted six events so far (facilitated by Fiona McIntyre and Natalia Alvarez), where people brought ideas, became part of the design team and created the first concept design supported by our architect Prof Gokay Deveci and Daria Belkouri from the Scott Sutherland School of Architecture at Robert Gordon University.

We have a conceptual design for our expansion based on a huge input of over 50 design ideas collated from our six co-creation events held to date.

We then plan to be ready with a full design concept to launch celebrate on our 2nd anniversary of opening in April.

Why co-creation?

We believe that people who use a place are in the best position to design solutions that meet their needs.

Our work is about facilitating collective thinking to design solutions with people that connect them to the coast, environment and heritage.

We are putting together a guide on how to co-create with people scalable solutions that empower communities and their connection to the coast.

FAQs

Is the Greyhope Bay Centre wheelchair accessible?

Yes, the centre is wheelchair accessible, and we have accessible toilets.

Are you dog friendly?

Yes, we welcome well behaved pets and their humans.

Do you have toilets?

We have two dry composting toilets on the upper car park.

What wildlife can I see?

Torry Battery is one of the best places in the UK to see bottlenose dolphins, with an 80% encounter rate on any given day. We regularly see seals and foxes, and have also spotted minke whales, porpoises, and otters. Over 200 species of birds have been recorded at the site, including gulls, eiders, short-eared owls, razorbills, and puffins. Come along, grab a cuppa and a pair of binoculars, and keep your eyes peeled!

Can I book a table?

We do not take bookings for tables in the café. If there isn't a table available on your arrival, we have benches outside the centre.

Who can I talk to about dietary requirements?

We would advise getting in touch with our café operators, Mount at Greyhope Bay, directly to discuss specific allergens or requirements via email: mountcafeaberdeen@gmail.com

Can I hire the space for private events?

We are not currently accepting bookings for parties at the Greyhope Bay Centre due to energy and space constraints. However, this is something we are considering for Phase 2 of our development.

Does the café serve lunches?

As we are operating completely off grid and have a small kitchen, we primarily offer coffee, hot and cold drinks, pastries and other sweet treats.

Celebrate our 2nd Anniversary


Mount at Greyhope Bay
