This will be the first part of our preparation for the confirmation that will take place in 2022. I shall be holding a retreat day and all who wish to be confirmed will be invited.

The group meets to help us understand the teaching of the Church on the environment and to help us as a Parish to see ways where as individuals, families and the Parish can work together to address the impact of our behaviour on our brothers and sisters and the world in which we live "Live Simply, that others may simply live!".
