The Pope Prays for Her Majesty the Queen

Pope Francis has sent a telegram to the Queen offering his prayers and good wishes. "On this joyful occasion of your Majesty's birthday, and as you celebrate this Platinum Jubilee year, I send cordial greetings and good wishes, together with the renewed assurance of my prayers that Almighty God will bestow upon you, the members of the Royal Family and all the people of the nation blessings of unity, prosperity and peace." the Pope also said he joins with those expressing appreciation for her persevering and steadfast service to the good of the nation, "the advancement of its people, and the preservation of its illustrious spiritual, cultural and political heritage." In recognition of the Queens commitment to the care of God's creation, Pope Francis is donating a Cedar of Lebanon to the Queen's Green Canopy initiative. He expressed the hope that this tree, "which in the Bible symbolises the flourishing of fortitude, justice and prosperity, would be a pledge of abundant divine blessings" upon her realm.

Help for Ukrainian Refugees | Companions of the Order of Malta: Given the restrictions on men leaving Ukraine, the majority of the adult refugees are women, many with children. The Companions of the Order of Malta are looking to provide volunteers for the Ukrainian church's activities. They have identified the key issues being raised by the refugees they are seeing as:

- English language;
- Getting a job;
- "Socialising".

We are hoping that we can identify a group of volunteers who would be prepared to help in any of the following initiatives:

- English language lessons for which we are looking to arrange some training/guidance for volunteers - and related to that "Conversation Buddies" (to build language skills and confidence);
- Mentoring/buddy arrangements (on a one-to-one or through support groups), particularly for young mothers;
- Assistance with job applications, CV writing and interview training;
- Providing tours round areas where refugees are being housed
 to identify useful places.
