Helping Homeless Young People: The problem of youth homelessness is becoming a dire situation and the Depaul Trust, inspired by St Vincent de Paul are doing their utmost to ensure that no young person experiences street homelessness, sleeps rough or is exposed to danger through homelessness. They are constantly bombarded with referrals from young people looking for nightly accommodations, but there is a severe shortage of volunteers to take them in for a night. Nightstop prevents homelessness through community hosting – providing a safety net to those forced to leave their homes. Nightstop places young people in a safe and warm home for the night, provided by a vetted and approved volunteer. This prevents young people from sleeping rough, "sofa surfing", or staying in an unsuitable accommodation where they would be at risk of abuse. The use of spare rooms in a positive environment makes a huge difference to young people in crisis. They support young people between the ages of 16 to 25. To achieve this, they rely on the generosity of good-hearted volunteer members of the community who provide a spare room for a night in their homes, a hot meal, warm bath and a listening ear to these young people for a night while our housing team work with them to provide lasting accommodation for them. Might you consider helping with this work for young people?

The next Marriage Preparation Course will take place in St Antony's Parish on **Saturday 5th & 12th November 2022, 10am-4pm**. Each couple must be able to attend both days in order to complete the course, which will include lunch. In order to register a place on the above course the couple must contact St Antony's parish office (forestgate@dioceseofbrentwood.org) for a registration form, which will need to be completed, signed and returned to the parish. Please note we will only accept couples once they have spoken to you and you have recommended they contact St Antony's to register, we will then deal with them direct for registration. We ask each couple for a £70 donation.
