 - 2. First command of Jesus before "you must . . . believe" (Mark 1:15)
 - **3.** First offer of the Gospel (Luke 24:47)
 - **4.** First response to the Gospel (Acts 2:38)
 - **5.** God's universal requirement (Acts 17:30)
 - **6.** First part of Paul's message (Acts 20:21)
 - 7. First command of Jesus to 5 out of 7 churches (Rev. 2 & 3)
 - **8.** "Turn us and we shall be turned" (Lam. 5:21)
 - **9.** Only the Father draws us (John 6:44)
- **B.** Forgiving
 - 1. Removes a barrier to our prayers (Mark 11:25)
 - **2.** Forgive us—as we are forgiven (Matt. 6:12)
- C. Life and blessing (Deut. 30:19–20)
 - 1. God offers them
 - 2. We must make the right choice
- **D.** Humility (1 Pet. 5:5–6)
 - 1. We must humble ourselves
 - 2. God can humiliate us but He cannot make us humble
- E. Speaking/singing in tongues (1 Cor. 14:15)
 - 1. Four times Paul says "I will . . ."

- 2. Speaking/singing in tongues is a *decision*
- **3.** Pentecost—disciples began to speak, then the Holy Spirit gave them the words (Acts 2:4)
- **4.** Pray in the Holy Spirit (Jude 20, 21) In the midst of ungodliness, we need to pray in tongues
