## What Is God Waiting For? 4383

Proclamation: Titus 2:11-14

Why has God tolerated so much evil so long?

What is He planning to get out of human history?

## I. A People For Himself (Titus 2:14)

Who will be His temple/dwelling place (2 Cor. 6:16)

- **A.** God's three successive dwelling places:
  - 1. The Tabernacle of Moses
  - **2.** The Temple of Solomon
  - **3.** The Church of Jesus Christ—the most costly Because:
    - **a.** The cost: the blood of Christ (1 Pet. 1:18–19)
    - **b.** The material: living (human) stones (1 Pet. 2:4–5)
      - (1) One human soul is worth more than the whole world (Mark 8:36)
      - (2) Man is a unique creation (describe) (Gen. 2:7)
      - (3) He jealously desires the Spirit which He has made to dwell in us" (James 4:5 NAS)
- **B.** For this reason God sent Jesus to earth: to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10)
- C. Man's No. 1 problem: he does not realize his own value

## II. What God Requires From Us

- **A.** Purity—eternal perspective
  - 1. Jesus purifies (Titus 2:14)
  - 2. We must purify ourselves (1 John 3:1–3; compare 1 Pet. 1:22)
    - **a.** We must cleanse ourselves (2 Cor. 6:16–7:1)
    - **b.** To focus only on this life makes us miserable (1 Cor. 15:19)
- **B.** To make Jesus central
  - 1. In the midst of the lampstands (= churches) (Rev. 1:12–13)
  - 2. In the midst of the throne (Rev. 5:6)
    We (the earth) revolve around the sun (Jesus)
- C. The people for whom God is waiting
  - 1. Out of every Tribe, Language, Nation, People (Rev. 5:9)
  - 2. God waits for *every one* whom He has chosen (2 Pet. 3:9)
