

Training Description

This continuing education event teaches participants the theory and foundational skills of Theraplay. Participants will learn the four Theraplay dimensions of Structure, Engagement, Nurture, and Challenge and how they are selected to target children's needs and address behavior problems. Participants will practice Theraplay skills and interventions in an interactive learning format. Training will be live and in-person only.

- 5. Explain how the MIM is utilized to assess the parent-child relationship and to plan treatment
