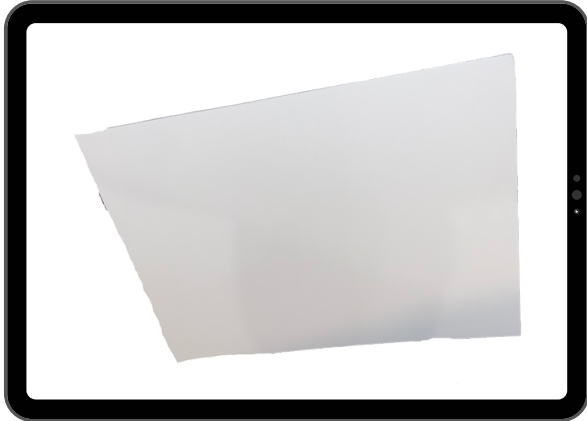
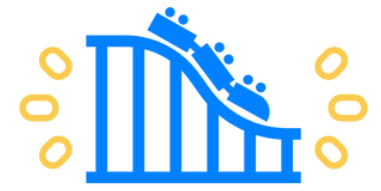
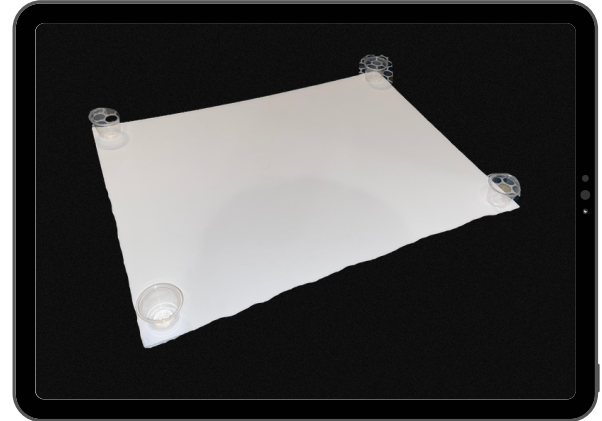


# Step-By-Step



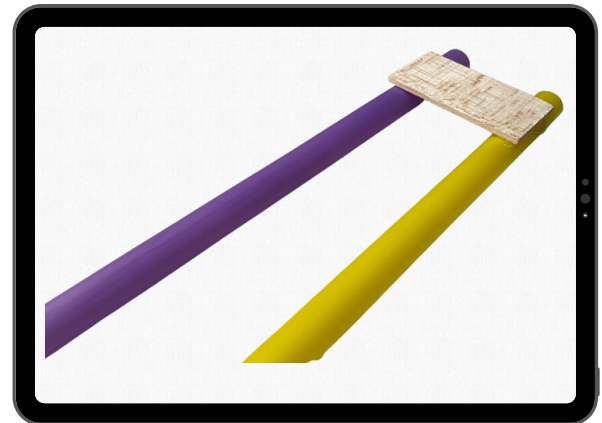
**1.** Grab your foam base  
\*\*Tape pieces together if need be!



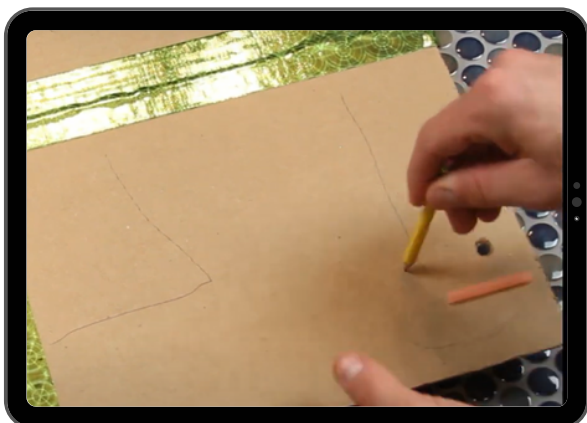
**2.** Place small cups or foam cubes on bottom corners to raise it up



**3.** Draw out your design and turns for your coaster



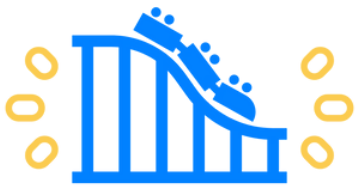
**4.** Make tracks by connecting straws and gluing them using smaller straw pieces



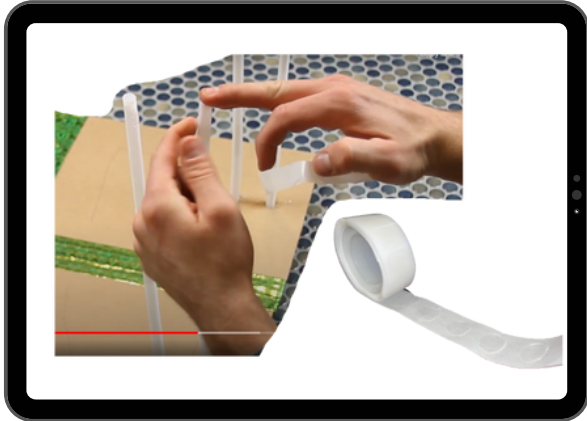
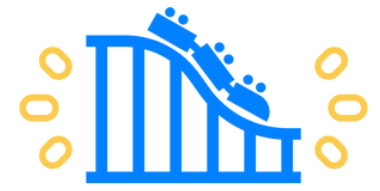
**5.** Use Pencil to poke holes for the coaster's poles



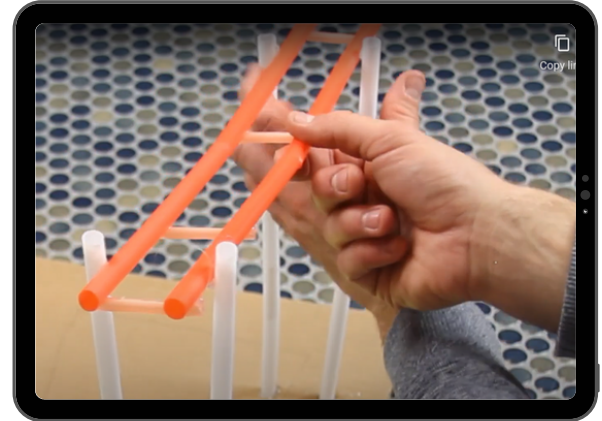
**6.** Insert poles into holes and put a drop of hot glue to keep them there



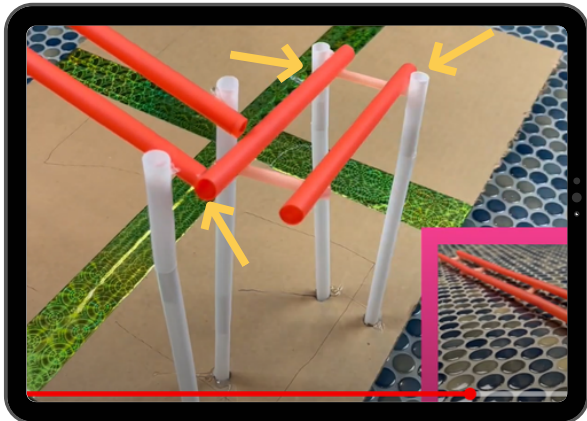
# Step-By-Step



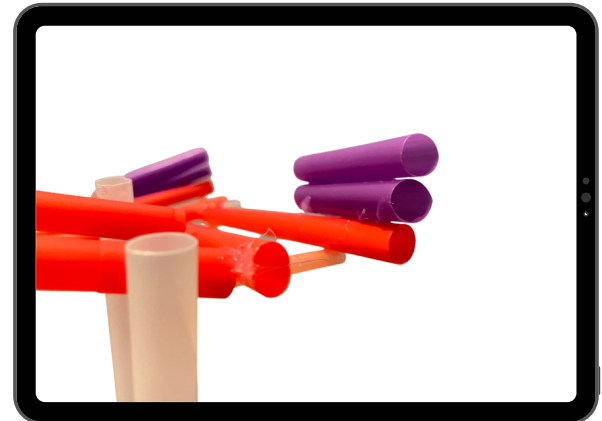
**7.** Use glue dots to temporarily connect tracks to poles



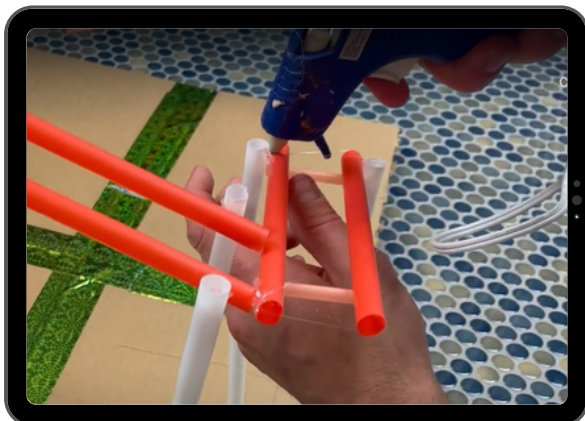
**8.** Cut tracks to length you want and stick sides to the glue dots



**9.** Cut new tracks and turn your coaster  
\*Arrows mark where glue dots help



**10.** Add bumpers at turns so balls do not fly over corners!



**11.** Add hot glue at connections to strengthen coaster. But be careful not to get it on top of the tracks!

## HELPFUL TIPS!!

- To connect straws: cut a slit in the straw, then pinch one end, and slide it inside a diff. straw
- Cut holes for poles the distance of small straws apart
- Make sure tracks are always pointed slightly down
- Test coaster along the way to make necessary adjustments
